## Denver Fire to Unveil New Fire Safety Simulator

Over the past two years, the Denver Fire Department Foundation has raised private funds to replace the old fire safety trailer that was retired from educational service in 2021. The new Fire Safety Simulator provides students of all ages and abilities an immersive and interactive learning experience. From common household fire scenarios to outdoor propane BBQ grills to FiAR fire extinguisher augmented reality (AR) training – this Fire Safety Simulator allows for an amazing educational opportunity for Denver’s students.
